

SchoolPower's Core

We are a non-profit education foundation with the mission to enrich the education and support the well-being of all children in the Laguna Beach Unified School District. We achieve our mission by providing programs, raising funds, and uniting the community in support of Laguna Beach students.

It Takes a Village

SchoolPower is governed by a board of trustees, most of whom are parents of LBUSD students. We rely on many hardworking volunteers, a small, dedicated staff, and a generous community. We work hand-in-hand with LBUSD educators to execute our programs.

Inspiring Educators

LBUSD provides an incredible climate for our teachers, staff, and coaches to continuously hone their craft. SchoolPower's goal is to help support innovation and enrichment by awarding grants in all areas—academics, athletics, music, visual and performing arts, student experiences, social emotional support, and more.

Here to Help

SchoolPower spearheads programs designed to support families. We know that after school enrichment is imperative to families and healthy for kids, so we provide a robust selection of classes through the After School Program. Our parenting book club is designed to build a culture of informed and connected parents in Laguna Beach. We partner with LBUSD at the Family Resource Center to offer family support services including aid for essential needs, scholarships for extracurricular and summer activities, tutoring referrals, and mental health resources.





Program Spotlight

schoolpower grants

One of our signature programs is the SchoolPower Grant Program. Teachers, coaches, counselors, and staff are invited to apply for SchoolPower grants at any time during the school year. Our goal is to encourage innovation and to support enrichment—the "extra stuff" that makes our schools here in Laguna so incredible.

In 2017, LBUSD recognized a national rise in families experiencing social and emotional distress throughout their education journey. With the support of the Board of Education and at the direction of the superintendent, the district built on its existing systems of support to expand access to school-based mental health services districtwide. They've since partnered with SchoolPower to consolidate a patchwork of existing support services into a single, more accessible place known as the Family Resource Center.

The vision is for the Family Resource Center to serve as a vibrant hub dedicated to building LBUSD family engagement by providing community activities, confidential counseling, and support services for student success. The FRC will be housed in the cottage at 733 St Ann's Drive, across from the LBHS track and field.

Funded primarily by LBUSD, with support from SchoolPower donors, the remodel of the cottage included creating private offices and a comfortable gathering space for small groups. Special thanks to community partners Kim Duensing Projects, The Shipp Group, Carolina Vergara Landscape Studio, and Nicol Architecture for their amazing work on the project.

This year, thanks to your support, SchoolPower's Family Support Services have continued to expand and evolve.



We helped over 300 parents learn and connect through our parenting book club, speaker series, and therapeutic creativity workshops.



Over 100 families received support for essential needs, mental health, tutoring, and extracurricular scholarships.



We offered scholarships so 11 LBHS seniors could be included in year-end activities and helped to support over 50 kids with their summer plans from UCI's 4-week COSMOS STEM program to the USA Volleyball National Team Development Program.

Program Spotlight

after school program

SchoolPower administers the After School Program at El Morro and Top of the World elementary schools. Families can choose from over 35 enrichment classes at each site during a session. Our goal is to support families' after-school care needs and to encourage kids to explore new areas and expand their interests.

Our impact includes:

74% of elementary students participated in the program

211 total classes offered

2,955 individual registrations for classes annually

296 students registered for two or more classes per session

65 kindergarteners participated in pilot classes

\$15,067 funded 52 scholarships for students in need





These figures represent actual revenue and expenses through fiscal year-end June 30, 2023.


SOURCE OF FUNDS*






The Laguna Beach Education Endowment and Capital Fund is a separate charitable foundation that complements SchoolPower.
