SchoolPower's Core

We are a non-profit education foundation with the mission to enrich the education and support the well-being of all children in the Laguna Beach Unified School District. We achieve our mission by providing programs, raising funds, and uniting the community in support of Laguna Beach students.

It Takes a Village

SchoolPower is governed by a board of trustees, most of whom are parents of LBUSD students. We rely on many hardworking volunteers, a small, dedicated staff, and a generous community. We work hand-in-hand with LBUSD educators to execute our programs.

Inspiring Educators

LBUSD provides an incredible climate for our teachers, staff, and coaches to continuously hone their craft. SchoolPower's goal is to help support innovation and enrichment by awarding grants in all areas—academics, athletics, music, visual and performing arts, student experiences, social emotional support, and more.

Here to Help

SchoolPower spearheads programs designed to support families. We know that after school enrichment is imperative to families and healthy for kids, so we provide a robust selection of classes through the After School Program. Our parenting book club is designed to build a culture of informed and connected parents in Laguna Beach. We partner with LBUSD at the Family Resource Center to offer family support services including short-term aid for families in crisis, scholarships to help students access extracurricular and summer activities, and parenting education events.









One of our signature programs is the SchoolPower Grant Program. Teachers, coaches, counselors, and staff are invited to apply for SchoolPower grants at any time during the school year. Our goal is to encourage innovation and to support enrichment—the "extra stuff" that makes our schools here in Laguna so incredible.

Thanks to your support, SchoolPower is able to fund support services and a staff member at the Family Resource Center.

Through SchoolPower's family support services, **over 150 families** received support for essential needs like backpacks, transportation, science camp supplies, clothing, and groceries.

We are committed to ensure all students have access to after school enrichment activities for exploration, growth, and fun. This year we offered grants for:

45 students to participate in SchoolPower's After School Program and Laguna Beach city and local recreation activities

- 24 LBHS seniors to enjoy year-end graduation activities
- **58** LBUSD students to access field trips, sports, and extra fun at the Boys & Girls Club
- **10** LBHS students to experience summer enrichment activities in areas from math to performing arts

We also helped **over 170 parents** learn and connect through our parenting book club. The group read and discussed *The Price of Privilege, The Emotional Lives of Teenagers,* and *The Power of Showing Up.*

Program Spotlight

after school program

SchoolPower administers the After School Program at El Morro and Top of the World elementary schools. Families can choose from over 30 enrichment classes at each site during a session. Our goal is to support families' after school care needs and to encourage kids to explore new areas and expand their interests.

Our impact includes:

- 71% of elementary students participated in the program
- 268 total classes offered
- 3,410 individual registrations for classes annually
- 243 students per session registered for two or more classes
- **\$26,580** in scholarships offered through the Family Resource Center to benefit 41 students

Over two thousand hours of baseballs caught, wool creatures felted, baskets and goals scored, robots built, flags captured, tree poses refined, recipes made, programs coded, paintings painted, chess games played, scenes performed, songs sung, side outs earned, science projects completed, and fun being had.



New for 2024-2025: District-led Spanish and music classes return, as well as SchoolPower-funded sustainability classes! Plus, based on parent feedback, we're rolling out a simplified schedule. We'll offer three sessions with more weeks per session to maximize after-school fun.





financial overview 2023-2024


These figures represent actual revenue and expenses through fiscal year-end June 30, 2024.




endowment fund


